PACKING Tips 1

Packing Procedure



Fill the empty spaces using newspaper or packing material to hold item securely inside the box.

Heavy items should be placed in the bottom of the box.

Apply packing tape to secure all box openings, including the bottom and edges.

The maximum weight should not exceed 55lbs (25kg).



I recommend to put the tape vertically to make the package strong.

PACKING Tips 2

How to pack? (by item)



Cups, mugs, and plates...

Pack each item individually with bubble wrap. Each piece of glassware should not touch together.



Bottles...

Double wrap all liquids with bubble wrap AND a plastic bag.

Wine, Whiskey...

Use a box with cushioning to pack these items, or use the double wrap method described above to cushion EACH bottle.



Clothing

Clothing should be folded and packed individually to avoid creases.



PACKING Tips 3

PC, Electronics, Other electric equipment...

DOUBLE or TRIPLE wrap and secure inside the box. Please remove all batteries.

Include an MSDS (Material Safety Data Sheet) if there is a built-in battery in the item.

Contact the manufacturer of the item for more information on packing the item for shipping.



You must sign a document when you ship electronic equipment.
